Implement in pieces of importance. What is needed first?

Need to be mobile, in the shortest amount of time Look at Illinois model to move resources quickly. LTRT's which are heavy rescue locally are fastest follow by the Type IV teams which can roll within 2 hours, etc. Reimbursement issue as well as licensure protection issue.

Training for teams including full scale exercise, position specific, storage and maintenance, administrative can be delayed.

CERFP- ANG has funding but no funding from state. Two months out but don't have funding for Palm Beach County to be prime agency. August 30th Sept. 1st. Will have maritime mission. CET and CERF-P will be conducting haz mat side of operation.
