NOTES:	Overwhelming requests for chainsaw training Developed an 8-hr course geared to emergency response personnel, getting ready to roll out. This was born out of a tremendous request for chainsaws. Need to make sure we are issuing the right equipment to the right people. Mitigation efforts continue post-Michael. Cleared 500 miles of fire lines. VFA have been expanded to those effected by Michael. Increased reimbursement for 50 to 100% Going to work more closely with the DEM to assist with IMT's to ensure we have the most effective resources available.

APCO		Hurricane Michael overview. Had multiple PSAP's, now called Emergency Communication Centers (ECC's) staffed with 60+ relief dispatchers. FEMA requires IS 144 and IS 1200 need to be completed to deploy dispatchers in disasters.
DSFM		PIO support needs to be more robust, including the SEOC in disasters. Going to lean forward earlier next time. Working to get additional funding for US&R and HM training through Legislative Budget Request (LBR) support.
DSRC		No report
FAPIO		Deployed 13 PIO's to Michael, PLUS others connected to US&R and IMT's. Delivering FEMA's Advanced PIO course. Recognized by EMI as having "Best Practices" for disaster communications.
FASAR		Working for sustained funding. Challenges with getting our numbers of canines up. Working closely with FNG and FWG with air deployments. Developing a comprehensive training plan. Refining to US&R Recon and Force Protection Con Op.
FDH		Michael stressed our ambulance deployment plan. Needs work.
FFS		Nothing additional
FLAHR		Team typing document was approved yesterday. Now developing deployment definitions from single-resources through full TF. From SERP, we need to better define how we integrate our HM resources.
FNG		Participated in HurrEx, lots of lessons learned. New TAG, General Eifert. Long history with Florida. Looking forward to supporting the mission especially with the ADSAR mission.
