TOPIC:	State Activations
NOTES:	Active season. We worked with FFS as well as the various hurricanes. Matthew presented a new challenge based on the path of the storm, all our assets were "pinned down". Completed exercises recently and are trying to bring new folks up. At the height we had 75 teams, 65 agencies, nearly 1,000 people moving around.
	John Kohnke brief on Matthew. \$1.8M in claims. Almost complete. Thanks to TJ for the help tracking things down. Reference the wildfires. Challenges with type of resources, local M/A, Regional M/A, and State activated. For Collier County there are 3 principals responsible for payment; County government, Sheriff, area impacted (Greater Naples and Lehigh). As of yesterday, asked FDEM for \$1.3M. We'll see. We have learned a lot and John encourages everyone to use the new spreadsheets for future claims. Just change the name and DON'T change the formulas.

## 5. Florida Forest Service Report (Fish)

Lack of rainfall and one of the warmest seasons in history.  2,607 wildfire to date, 257,00 acres burned, 5,786 homes/business threatened, 55 homes/businesses destroyed (1%), 25 FFS STs primarily from panhandle, 3 IMTs, 6 ESTs, MARC, various M/A responses, 3 approved FMAG's: Lee, Collier, Polk. Utilized resources from the SE FS as well. Other partners with huge success, FPS, FWC, also provided tremendous assistance. Utilization of County Burn Bans proved challenging in the beginning but in the end proved to be the best option.  Still working on AAR's. Successes realized thus far – Excellent safety record, heat exhaustion was the biggest problem not to be unexpected. Had two burn-overs, lost 1 dozer. 99% save
was the biggest problem not to be unexpected. Had two burn-overs, lost 1 dozer. 99% save
rate for homes/businesses, outstanding.
Challenges – UAV incursions, problem nationwide. They serve a purpose but still challenges. Keeping the numbers of trained personnel, we have a young workforce. Staffing structural engines to meet WFF standards. Reminder as the minimum quals; S100, S130/190 for FFs, ISCS 200, S 215 for OIC; S330 and ICS 300 for STLs; Structure protection specialist require S290 and S270
Qualifications and Requirements
Kasey Crow – Challenges with current IQS tracking, 5 year limit, changing departments. Determined FCDICE may be the solution as it would be linked to the individual, regardless of where they work. Now trying to transfer the info from IQS to FCDICE.
NWCG requires performance and proper instructor credentialing. There is a crosswalk process to allow personnel to become instructors.
