6. Review Mental Wellness Response Initiative (Halas)

TOPIC:	Surfside Response
NOTES:	<p>Early in the Surfside response, brought up the issue of mental wellness. Two individuals were identified and a Mental Wellness Group under the IMT EMS Branch. This was a collaborative effort between DOH, EMS, and the H&S Collaborative.</p> <p>Ended up with about 24 folks assigned to the Group including the IAFF Peer Support.</p> <p>Reviewed post-analysis document provided by the Group.</p> <p>Not only supported the first responders but the families of those missing.</p> <p>Lessons learned, start early with deploying resources.</p>

TOPIC:	Pre-Assignment of logins to US&R TFs and their sub-units
NOTES:	Define and assign TF/Unit IDs so teams can use yearround for training, exercises and deployments <ul style="list-style-type: none">• FL-TF1-RSQ1
